STATE AND INTERNATIONAL ORGANISATIONS PARTNERSHIP

GOAL

to create incentives for youth development in Ukraine and its return to Ukraine by means of GRANTS for young people



Focus

- country's recovery through volunteering
- youth entrepreneurship and employment
- skills required for the country's recovery and strengthening the viability



Needs

- financial support to provide grants for young people
- UYF institutional capacity building
- UYF policy development
- UYF online work mechanism introduction

FLAGSHIP PROJECT

“United Ukraine”

GOAL

development of democratic, conscientious and responsible society; formation of civic position and preparation of society to civil defense; formation of safety environment



Main tasks

- to overcome post-colonial and post-totalitarian destructive consequences in the consciousness of the Ukraine’s population;
- to popularise cultural heritage, Ukrainian values, state language as components of national identity;
- to increase the number of the population ready to fulfill the duty of protecting the independence and territorial integrity of Ukraine;
- to increase the number of civil defense specialists and instructors.



Focus

- implementation of the Law of Ukraine "On the Basic Principles of State Policy in the Field of Affirming Ukrainian National and Civil Identity" BY MEANS OF
- conducting a comprehensive study of the national identity of Ukrainian youth
- normative legal support and scaling-up of the training of civil defense specialists and instructors
- finalising and popularisation of a unified information platform “United Ukraine” for non-formal education of the population



Needs

- Conduct "United Ukraine" research on the formation of national and civic identity among young people in the Euro-Atlantic context;
- Increase the capacity of the “United Ukraine” project, in particular, the formation and popularisation of content;
- Joint practical training of civil defense specialists, support for their activities in the de-occupied territories and involvement of internally displaced persons.

FLAGSHIP PROJECT

Implementation of European sports model in Ukraine

GOAL

introduction of a new activity regulation system in the field of physical culture and sports



Priorities

- formation of a healthy nation
- introduction of a club system
- sports autonomy, capacity development of civil society institutions
- efficient use of sports facilities
- digitalisation



Focus

- creation of incentives for regular health-improving physical activities
- development of a legislative mechanism for financing sports clubs based on the principle "Money goes to service"
- creation of a regulatory and legal basis for the transfer of authority to federations and increasing the level of their institutional capacity
- available sports facilities for physical activity and sports
- transparent digital mechanism for the use of funds from the rental of sports facilities and the development of sports infrastructure



Needs

- Expert support for developing legislative changes
- Expert examination of existing legislation
- Expert support for implementation of reform (expert support team)
- Funding for the development of the registry of sport organizations
